





2012 Morgan 3-Wheeler Sold Last Month By Steve Blake

This 2012 Morgan 3-Wheeler was reportedly purchased new by the seller from Morgan West in Santa Monica, California, and it now has 768 miles. Powered by a 1,979cc V-twin paired with a five-speed manual transmission, it is finished in green over brown leather. Equipment includes Spitfire livery graphics, a tonneau cover, a chrome-finished nose panel, Brooklands-style windscreens, black fenders, dual polished side pipes, a luggage rack, aviation-style instrumentation, an MP3 horn, chrome roll hoops, and 19" wire-spoke front wheels with three-eared knock-off hubs. This 3-Wheeler is now offered in Massachusetts with manufacturer's literature and a clean Montana title in the name of the seller's corporation. The air-cooled 1,979cc "X-Wedge" V-twin was manufactured by S&S Cycle and is equipped with an Urban Electric fan kit and upgraded rectifier as well as a chrome S&S air cleaner. The oil was changed and the battery replaced in 2023.


